KM pee wees lose to Forest City 38-0

Kings Mountain's Optimist Club pee wee football team fell to Forest City 38-0 in Pop Warner League action Saturday.

The Mountaineers played well in the first half, gaining over 100 yards total offense and having seven first downs to Forest City's two, but committed two costly fumbles which helped Forest City run up a 21-0 halftime lead.

Derek Gary led the KM offense with 42 yards rushing, followed by D.J. Alexander 41, Samone Hunter 34, and Jamar Currence 11.

Hunter, Austin Link, Currence and Derek Johnson led the defense with four tackles each. Monyell Ward had three, Gary two and James Biggers, Randy Short, Anthony Hopper and Shawn Thompson one apiece.

"They've probably blocked six kicks in the three games that I've seen," said Massey. "They rush the punter and cause a lot of safeties from the punter not being able to handle the ball. That's a big concern of ours."

So, what will be Mountaineers have to do to counter that exceptional talent?

"We're going to have to play with a lot of emotion," Massey said. "We're going to have to make

some big plays and try to limit them from making them."

Another big key, he said, will be how the Mountaineers execute their special teams. Last week, that phase of the game came to life for the first time this year, returning a punt and a pass interception for touchdowns in a 38-7 win over R-S Central.

Defensively, Massey said the Mountaineers must force the Cavaliers into a lot of three and out situations and create good field position for the Mountaineer offense.

"We've got to make some positive yardage on first and second

down," he said. "We can't let them put us in a third and long situation. They thrive on that."

Concentration and execution will be a big key if the Mountaineers are to win.

"It's going to be a tough ball game," Massey said. "If we can keep it close going into the fourth quarter we'll have an opportunity to win. If we let them jump out like they did last year and we have to play catch-up it will be tough. They have some kids going both ways. If we can get in the fourth quarter and be in striking distance I'll feel pretty good about it."

SAY NO To City Council on October 27, 1998
Additional Beer And Wine Sales on SUNDAY

My Position:

1. No Additional Beer and Wine sales on Sunday in Kings Mountain.
2. Demand that the Alcohol Law Enforcement (ALE) Agency audit the present four or five establishments operating under the so-called "Restaurant Loophole Provision" to verify their compliance with the law. If they are not in compliance, then revoke their licenses to sell on Sunday.

The request to permit all establishments to sell on Sunday is being promoted on the basis of "Fairness" and "Revenue Generation".

I recommend that you recall the promises of giant revenue windfalls to result from establishment of the ABC store. We know that additional revenue generation will be very small, probably insignificant.

As to "fairness", I ask citizens to come to City Hall on October 27, to state your opinion of automobile deaths and injuries, drunk drivers, alcoholism, child abuse, jailed family members and other negative results of alcohol. Should we add in any small way to increase a known abuse? It is time to vigorously enforce the existing laws concerning alcohol, drugs and gambling in Kings Mountain.
