



KM Military Park develops fire plan

Kings Mountain National Military Park superintendent Erin Broadbent recently announced that the park is in the final approval stages for the park's new Fire Management Plan. As in many other federal and state agencies, the plan call for the implementation of a prescribed fire program to assist managers in forest protection and cultural landscape restoration. The need for the plan was identified in 1996 after a vascular plant study indicated that the heavy fuel layer was contributing to the decline in the park's biodiversity., Recently, a cultural landscape report further supported the use of fire as management tool to aids in the restoration of the cultural landscape. Park Staff have completed the Environmental Assessment and have found no significant impact to the environment as a result of imple-

A National Park Service Fire Use Model based a the Great Smoky Mountains National Park has begun preparation of the burn plan, and a Fire Effects Monitoring Crew has established research plots within the burn arena.


