his request to rezone the prop-
erty but will still appear before
City Council to express his con-
cern over how the matter was

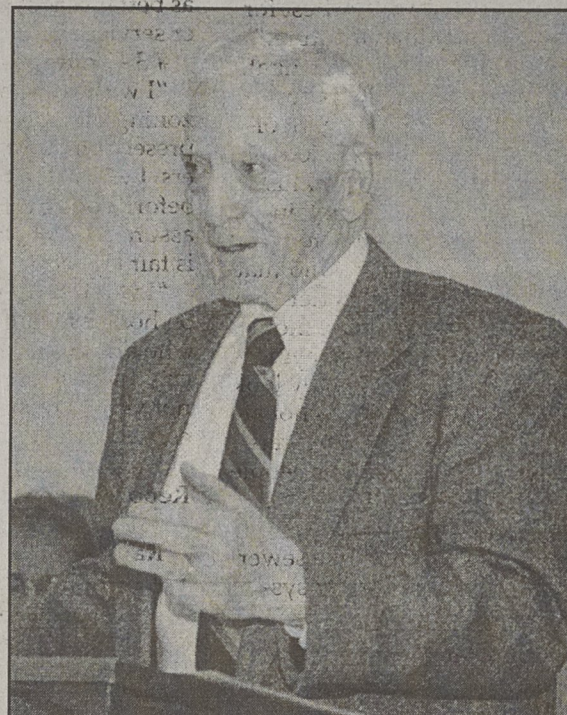
