

Holiday trash pick-up schedule

The pick-up schedule for the City of Kings Mountain household trash for the week of December 25 and January 1 will be one day behind.

Monday's route will be run on Tuesday; Tuesday's route will be run on Wednesday; Wednesday's route will be run on Thursday; and Thursday's route will be run on Friday for both of these weeks.

Trash must be rolled to curbside by 7:30 a.m. For the week

of Christmas the city will pick up additional bags of trash which will not fit into the roadside container. Residents should make sure additional trash is placed beside the container in trash bags. It will not be picked up if it is placed on top of the container.



The regular pick-up schedule will resume the week of January 8.

KM POLICE REPORT

Searches net 4 arrests

Kings Mountain Police Narcotics Division executed two search warrants last week resulting in the arrest of four people.
