## \$1.8 million allocated for county paving

SHELBY - Cleveland County will have more paved roads and the new bypass completion date will be later, according to an N.C. Department of Transportation representative at the Cleveland County Board of Commissioners meeting Tuesday night.

The DOT's road improvement program will include nine roads, a majority of them are in the northern part of the county, plus an additional road in a subdivision.

When the current \$1.8 million dollar program is complete, NCDOT Maintenance Engineer Joe Lamb said 75 state-maintained roads will be unpaved, which translates to 133 miles.

The money for the state-funded project is based on funds available during the current fiscal year, and the entire amount available can not be determined until June 30.

Although most of the roads that will be paved are in the upper part of the county, Lamb said there is no specific method to determine which roads need to be paved.

"There's no particular rhyme or reason," he said. "This is totally an unbiased thing because we have our folks go out and do the counts, and so they don't try to gerrymander anything to get something paved. They just input the information on the computer and it spits out a list of the highest to the lowest of reports. We just take it as the information hits," he said.

Lamb said the DOT also considers the number of homes, businesses, churches and school bus travel before prioritizing roads that need to be paved.

The state has designated \$232,304 of the money for spot stabilization and secondary maintenance; and \$351,831 will be reserved for contingencies.

The roads being paved in order of priority are: Rippy Road, Sand Pit Rd., Brooks Chapel Rd., Buck Chapman Rd., Barbee Rd., Sand Hill Rd., two parts of Moriah Church Rd., North Lee Rd. and Marco Place, which is in a subdivision.

Regarding the new bypass, Lamb said a public hearing has been tentatively set for 2002 and construction will begin two years later.

He said construction would be finished by 2016.

Traffic will only increase, Lamb said, when construction begins on the new bypass.

"We've got growth," Lamb said. "We've got a Wal-Mart distribution center proposed that's going to put a lot more trucks out there on 74, even without things like that you still have growth every year," Lamb said.

Lamb said, getting all the traffic signals would help improve the flow on the current bypass.

"The only thing is we may have some improvements we can make that may help traffic flow a little better," Lamb said.

A full-time nurse and receptionist would be assigned to the office.

Stallings said the \$47,000 she requested for startup money would include such items as furniture, equipment, phone lines, computers and computer lines, and \$28,000 annual rent.

"Hopefully we'll know something definite (about the Kings Mountain office) Tuesday night," she said. "I can't really say right now what our Board will recommend."

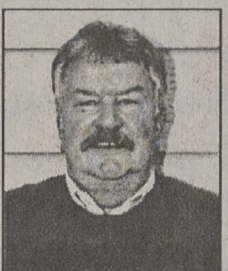
