On January 18, he will be at Crest High School at 9:30 a.m. and Burns High at 1:30 p.m.

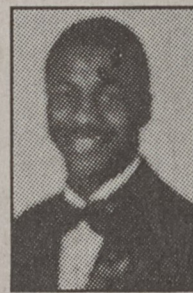
On January 22, he will be at Shelby High at 9:30 a.m. and Kings Mountain High School at 1 p.m.

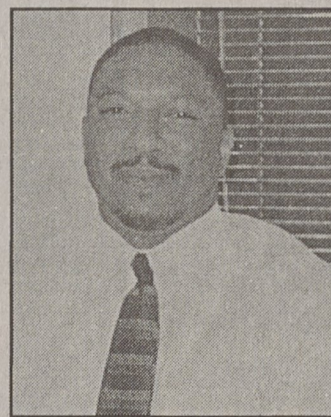

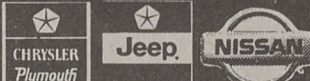

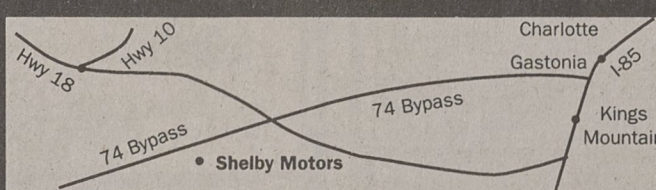
