Harris-Welco to cut 49 jobs by mid-July

While Kings Mountain has been benefiting from the recent job announcements, with several companies planning moves to the area, one city employer will be trimming its workforce.

Harris-Welco, a welding supply manufacturer and distributor, will have cut 49 jobs

by mid-July, according to company officials. The two sides affected will be manufacturing and distribution, whose jobs will be consolidated at the plant's Mason, Ohio

Harris-Welco General Manager said the employees will be offers severance packages based on years of service.

Layoffs began with announcements in October and May, he said.

"It was just consolidating operations, pretty much," Pandorf said.

The remaining Kings Mountain jobs will be office positions.

One of the companies that has announced its plans to move to Kings Mountain is

Michigan-based Blachford which makes noise reduction materials for trucks and automobiles.

It will occupy the former Wix/Dana Building, 707 Broadview Drive.

The company, which will move its plant from Crossville, Tenn., will be one of the largest electricity users, which may ease the loss of Anvil Knitwear.

Blachford will bring 80 jobs to Kings Mountain and production is expected to start in September.

Cleveland County commissioners gave preliminary approval at its last meeting for 89 new full-time jobs in the county when it approved an industrial incentive grant for \$11,500 for Elastic Fabrics L.L.C., to start production at the former Cleveland Mills building in Lawndale. The company's expected level of investment is expected to be \$3,300,000.

The Lawndale building has been vacant since it closed last year.

The job announcements could also help lower Cleveland County's unemployment rate which is at 12 percent.

The county had the highest jobless rate multiple times during the past year.


