Shull said an occupant in the vehicle occupied by Hispanics reportedly threw a beer bottle and hit a window of the other vehicle, shattering the glass on an infant in a child seat. He said the Owensby vehicle sped up to try to get out of the way, but the other vehicle attempted to pass in the right hand lane and ran off the shoulder near a guard rail. The Owensby vehicle applied brakes to slow down and was struck on the driver's side, causing it to lose control and go across two lanes of traffic and slide into a grassy area, striking a fence and rolling over twice before coming to rest on Woodlake Parkway.

Shull said four of the Hispanics were located and transported to hospitals, but the driver and another passenger have not been locat-

There was \$14,000 damage to the Hispanics' vehicle, owned by Karen R. Nunez of Tucson, AZ, and \$2,000 damage to the Owensby vehicle.
