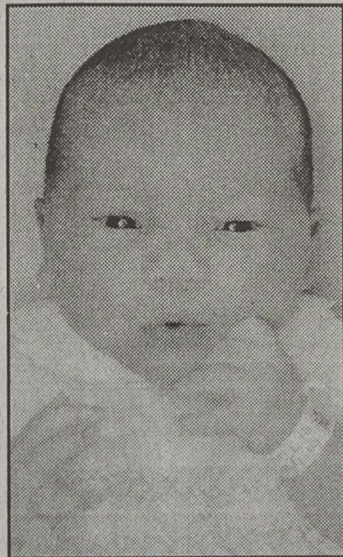
Zachary Humphries celebrates birthday
