St.' among events planned for holiday season

The 'Little Blue Choo' with Rick Walker as engineer will zip folks up and down Main St. and carriage rides will be offered on Main St. and Elm St. A full slate of musical entertainment will highlight the festivities.

The entertainment schedule features violinists George and Courtney Beam from 6 - 6:30 p.m., the Cherryville High School band from 6:30 - 7 p.m., and Rev. Ron Lackey and family from 7 - 7:30 p.m. The music continues with Bart Fortenberry from 7:30 - 8 p.m., the group, 'Radicals for Christ,' from Fairview

Baptist Church from 8 - 8:30 p.m. and the band, 'Double Edged Sword,' featuring Lee Hefner and other teenage musicians from 8:30 - 9 p.m.

Cherryville's award-winning mandolin player Darin Aldridge will perform outside of Mabry's Supplies beginning at 7 p.m. and the Cherryville High School chorus will present a variety of Christmas carols from 6 - 7 p.m. at the C. Grier Beam Truck Museum.

Four food vendors will also be available, according to chamber official Diana Beam. Beam said the 'Christmas on Main St.' event is shaping up to be a big celebration.

Beam said the annual Christmas parade is "looking good" with 59 entries registered for the procession. She expects more to enter this week.

The parade steps off down Main St. on Saturday,

December 14, 2002 at 10:30 a.m. with professional NHRA racing champion Doug Herbert leading the way as grand marshal. The parade will feature elected officials, floats, bands, beauty queens, antique cars and trucks, clowns and the Shriners. A number of local organizations will participate in the parade as well as the big guy himself, Santa Claus. Several Little Miss Gastonia pageant winners will ride on the Santa Claus float, according to Beam.

Christmas activities continue with the Cherryville High School chorus concert on Saturday, December 14, 2002 from 6 - 7 p.m. at First United Methodist Church of Cherryville. The Cherryville High School band will present its winter concert on Sunday, December 15, 2002 at Starnes Auditorium beginning at 3 p.m.
