DISTANCE LEARNING WITH CLEVELAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE
Distance Learning is education that takes place when you and the teacher are separated by space or time. The gap between you is bridged through the help of technology or non-traditional methods. Some ways of connecting students and teachers include e-mail, the World Wide Web, closed-circuit cable television, video and audiotapes, videoconferencing, satellite broadcasts, and voice mail.

You would be a good candidate for distance learning if:

- You need the convenience of distance learning due to family life, work schedules and other factors.
- You are highly motivated to succeed.
- You are disciplined enough to incorporate study time into your busy daily activities.
- You have been successful in previous traditional course environments.
- You have been making good grades in your earlier work and have all of your work complete and in on time.
- You are willing to attend any mandatory orientation or testing sessions on campus.

TELECOURSES
Students "attend class" by watching videotaped lessons and reading supplemental materials at their home with guidance from the faculty. These courses are the same in content, requirement, and credit as on-campus courses. Students must attend an orientation session with their instructor where they will receive a course syllabus and other materials and meet with other telecourse students.

INTERNET COURSES
There are several requirements for Internet delivered courses that differ from the traditional classroom. Students will need some form of Internet access. You do not necessarily have to have your own Internet Service Provider account at home, but you must have access somewhere. It may be at school in the computer lab, at a friend or family member's house, etc. Obviously it is better and more convenient to have an account at home where you can work any time. Since some courses may require other hardware and/or software requirements, students should contact the instructor listed below or their advisor before registering. Some on-campus time will be required.
