# Diabetes seminar held Wednesday at Patrick Center

A seminar on diabetes drew approximately 40 people to the Patrick Senior Center Wednesday.

Registered dietitian and diabetes educator Patricia Cherry told the crowd that 90 percent of her clients are diabetic. She explained that diabetes is affected not only by diet but stress and activity level.

"It's not just what you eat. I want you to know that to get rid of some of that guilt," she said.

The disease is hereditary and is more common in people of color and women. Excess weight and a sedentary lifestyle are risk factors

Cherry dispelled beliefs that diabetics must only avoid sugar.

"It's not just a sugar thing. It's a carbohydrate thing," she said.

Carbohydrates are found in bread, pasta, crackers,

beans and starchy vegeta-

Cherry stressed the importance of looking at blood sugar levels over time, not just what a quarterly doctor visit reveals. She explained that activity can bring sugar levels

Contrary to popular belief, not eating can result in a high blood sugar reading. The liver will produce glucose when an individual does not eat enough, Cherry

Seminar participants received a free blood sugar meter from Bayer HealthCare. The company co-sponsored the seminar with Mountain Street Pharmacy.

Cherry represented CaroMont Wound and Diabetes Centers, a division of Gaston Memorial Hospital.

Staff from Cleveland County Home Health Agency provided free blood sugar testing.
