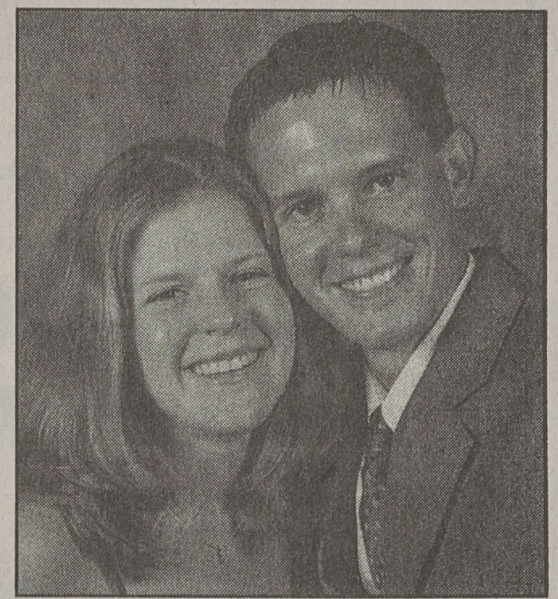
## Hope McCoy-James Mauney Jr.
