Reflections dance studio under the direction of Susan Morris performed.

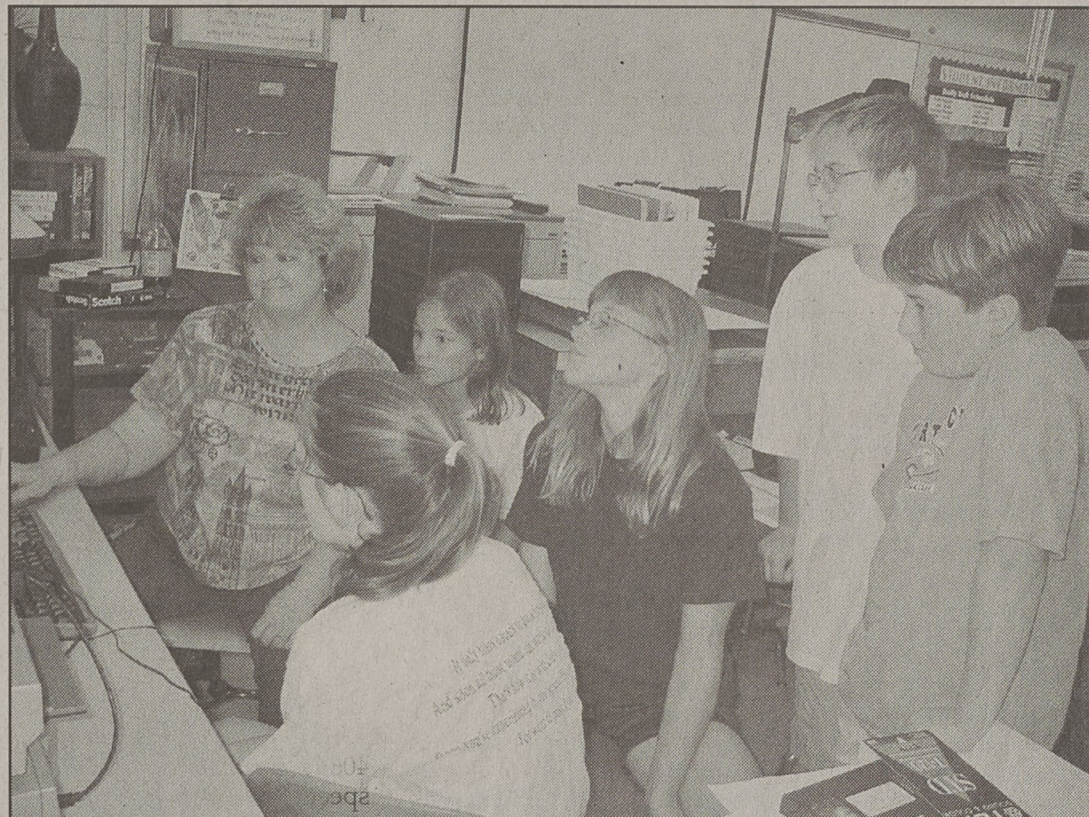
Haywood Homsley, president of the African-American Political Caucus of Cleveland County spoke. George and Sharon Roberts

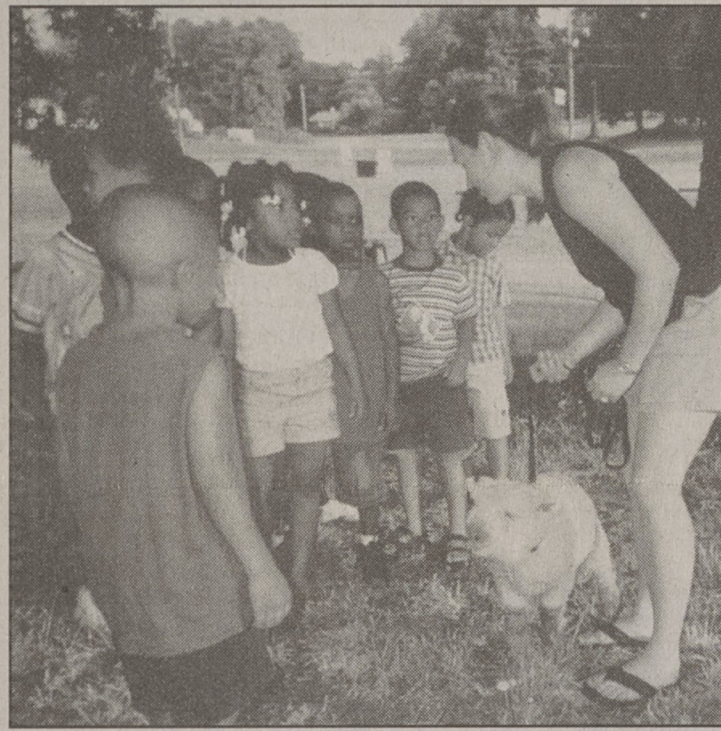

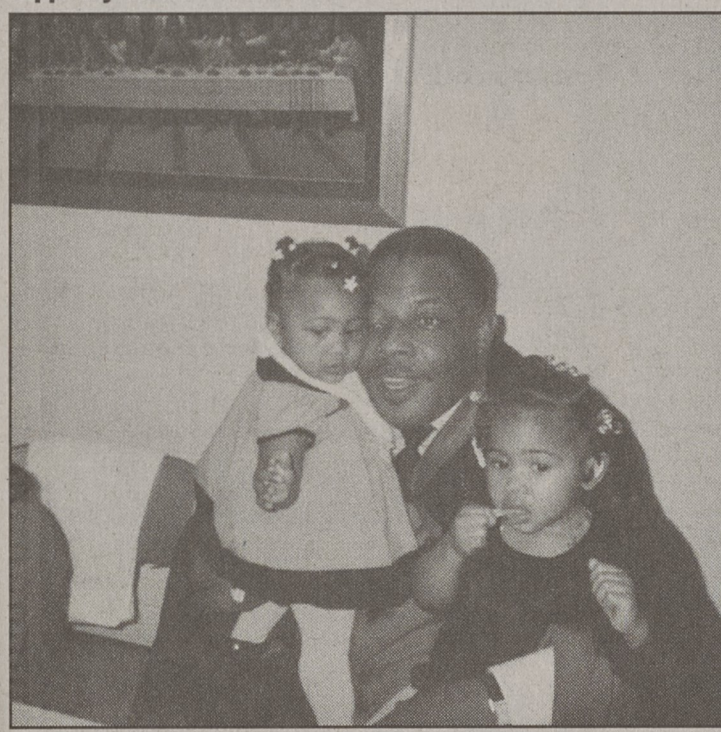
