MEDITATION

We can go home again

BY JEFF HENSLEY

Growing up in Asheville, I was still young when I became acquainted with the early twentieth century novelist Thomas Wolfe. Of his works, the one that has impressed me the most was

published in 1938, and it happens to be the one for which he is most known.

This particular **Jeff Hensley**

novel is Meditation something * of an autobiographical sketch that describes a haunting search for meaning in life. George Webber, the protagonist of the story, published a highly successful novel, followed by a second but these did not bring him a sense of fulfillment.

When his search for meaning led him back to his hometown of Libya Hill, George discovered that things were not the same. The greed of the town leaders repulsed him. He then went to Germany. He had always felt a kinship with the German people, but in 1936 they were far different than he had remembered.

So George returned to America, only to be disillusioned with the direction America was taking. His unfulfilled longing to rediscover the stability and peace of his past led George to the conclusion that "You Can't Go Home Again," which was the phrase Wolfe chose for the title of his book.

I have been away from my hometown now for over twenty years, so I can understand why Wolfe said, "You can't go home again." There have been many changes in my hometown,

but the ones that matter the most to me have to do with the people I knew there. A number of those people have either moved away or died, so even though the skyline may be about the same it just isn't the home I left behind.

It may be true that a person can't go home again in the physical sense, but I believe that Wolfe was wrong in one important way, for we can go home again in a spiritual sense. One of my favorite Bible stories describes how we can all go home again to our Creator, to a God who loves us like a father loves his own son.

There were three characters in this familiar Bible story. There was a son who ran away from home, a father who never gave up on the son, and a second son who, though he never left home, was not really at

home with his father. When the rebellious son wanted to leave, the father was flexible and let him go. While he was away from home, the father waited patiently. And when the son wanted to come home again, the father welcomed him with love and forgiveness.

We call this story the parable of the "Prodigal Son," but theologian Helmut Thielicke calls it the parable of the "Waiting Father" because the main character in the story is not really the wayward son, but the waiting father. From this story we all learn that God loves us with an unchanging and unconditional love. So Wolfe was wrong in a sense, because we can go home
