# Childers, Barrett no-hit Shelby for 10th straight softball win

Kings Mountain High's women's softball team blasted country rival Shelby 29-1 in four innings in Southwestern 2A/3A Conference action Tuesday at Lancaster Field.

The win leaves the Lady Mountaineers with a 8-0 conference and 10-0 overall record.

The Mounties scored 16 runs in the first inning and 10 in the second.

Morgan Childers led the plate attack with 4-for-4, including a double, solo home run, grand slam home run, nine RBI and four runs scored.

Brittney Thornburg was 3-for-4 with two doubles and a home run, three RBI and four runs scored. Casey Camp was 3-for-4 with a triple, four RBI, four runs and two stolen bases. Krystyn Funderburke was 3-for-5 with a double.

Courtney Tate had two hits and Haley Barrett and Jessica Yarbro added one apiece.

Childers and Barrett combined for a no-hitter. Childers worked the first inning and struck out all three batters. Barrett pitched the final three innings. She faced 14 batters, walking two and fanning four.

Shelby all turned in scores of 5-over-par 77. Allen shot a 39 on the front side and a 38 on the back.

Other KM scores were Hogan Sellers 84, Chris Miller and C.J. Cooke 94 each, Reid Smith 97 and Corry Phillips 101.

Shelby led in team scoring with a 332, followed by R-S Central 334, KM 349, Burns 367, Chase 368 and East Rutherford 379.

After three matches, Shelby leads the conference with a 978 total, followed by R-S 988, KM 1055, Chase 1080, Burns 1121 and East 1151.

Ridings leads the individual scoring with a 231 cumulative score. Allen is sixth with a 245.
