

TACO SOUP **JEAN HARRIS**

2lbs. hamburger 1 onion, chopped

- 2 (15 oz.) cans pinto beans, with juice
- 2 cans stewed tomatoes 2 cans corn, with juice 1 pkg. taco seasoning
- 1 pkg. ranch dressing

3 T. picante sauce 1 cup water

Grease and flour a 10 inch tube cake pan. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Add dry gelatin to dry cake mix and blend well. Add 3/4 cup of the water, the lemon flavoring, vegetable oil. Add one egg at a time and blend well after each addition. Beat batter about 4 minutes on medium speed of mixer. Pour batter into a greased 10 inch tube cake pan; bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the cake comes out clean. Allow cake to cool in pan about 15
