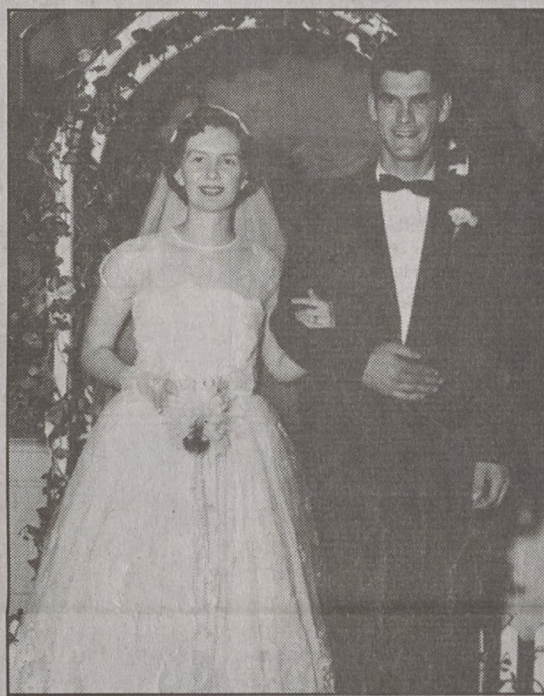
## Mary and Herman Greene celebrate 50th anniversary

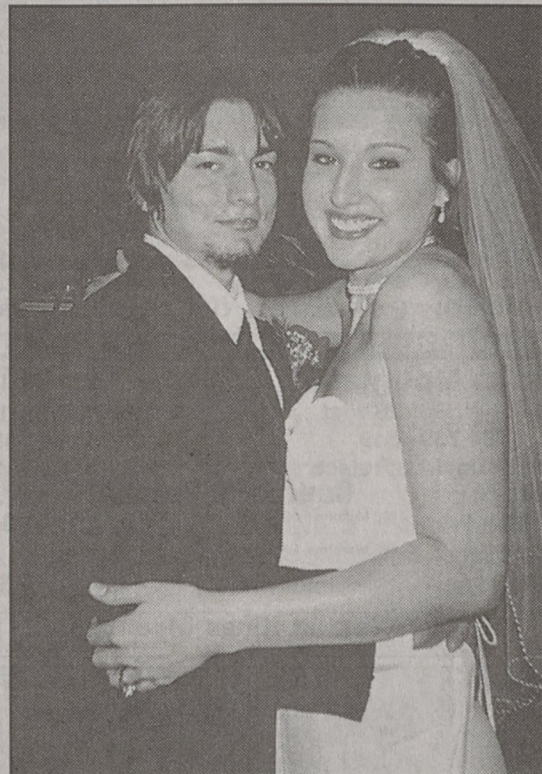
