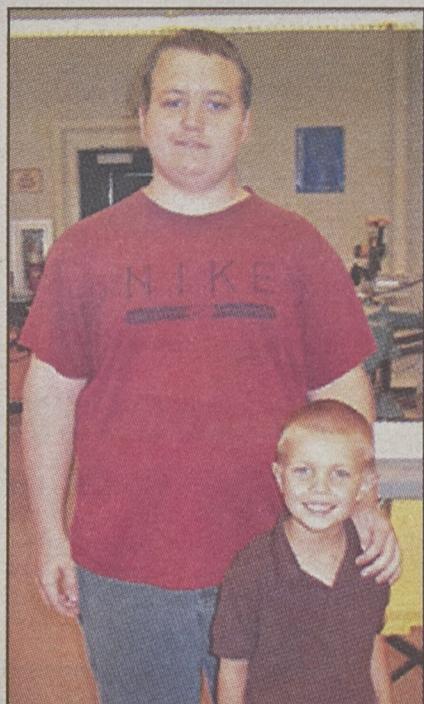

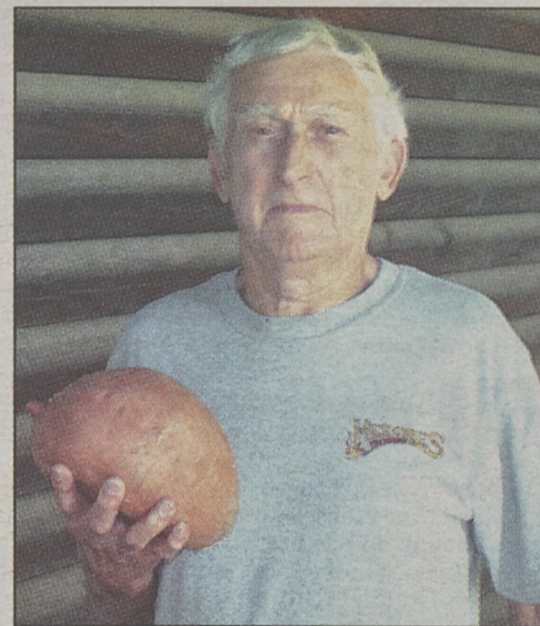
Andrew Radford, 17, and Eli Radford, 5, enjoyed exploring KM High's new BIT building.



Mayor Robert Sides hosted a grand party at Grover Town Hall recently for county government officials.

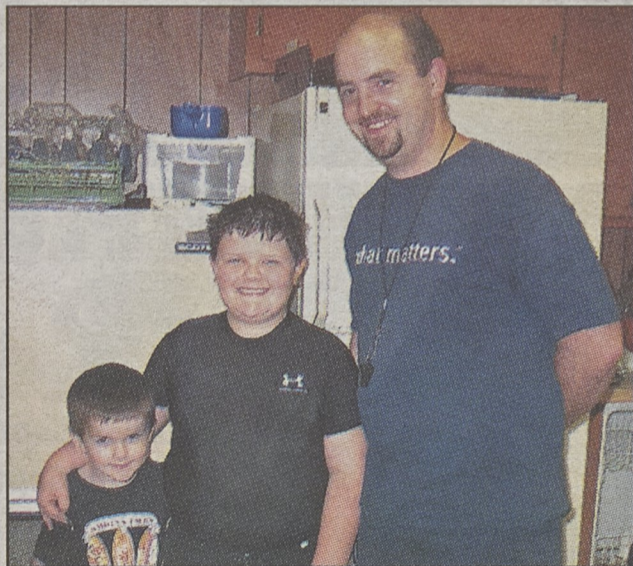

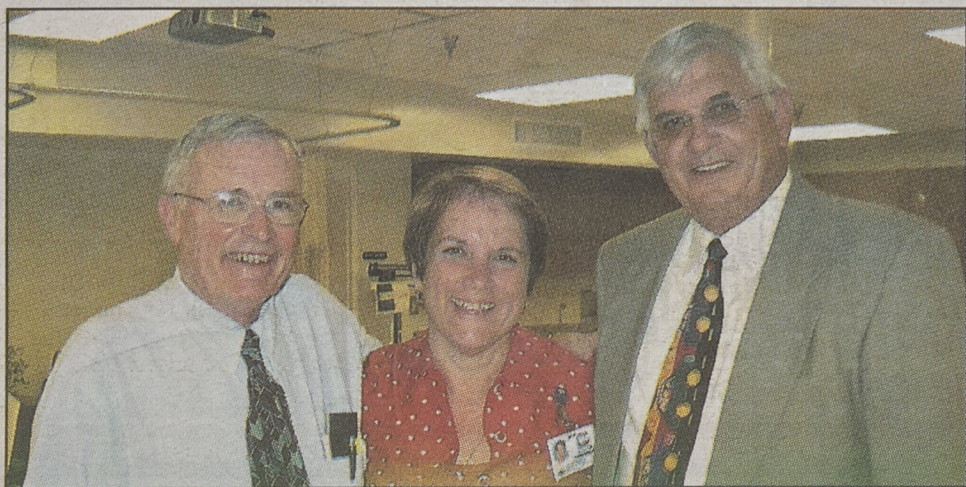


Raeford White grew this 4 1/2-pound sweet potato in his garden in Kings Mountain.
