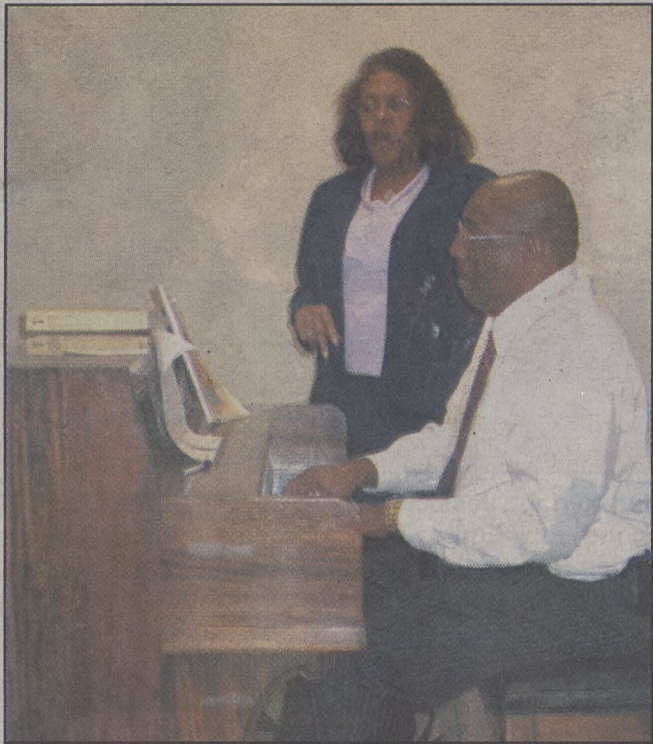


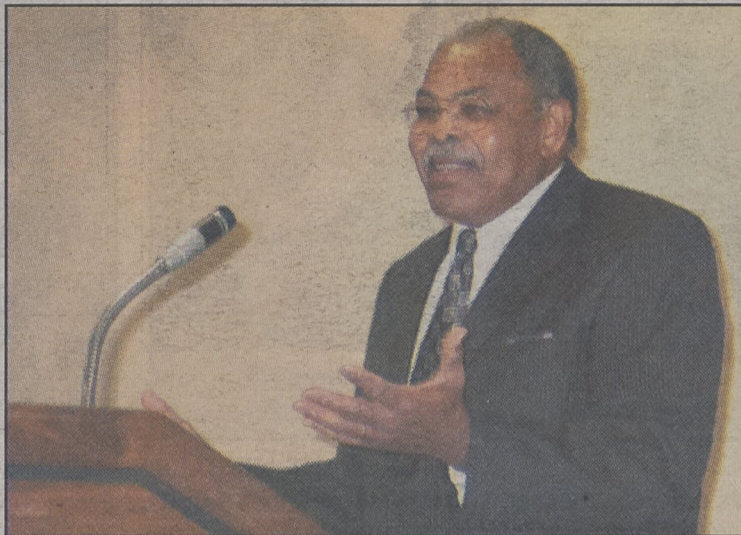

Samuel Burris, Jr., served as guest speaker for the Patrick Center's recent Black History Program, entitled "Reflections and the Rewards of Being United."



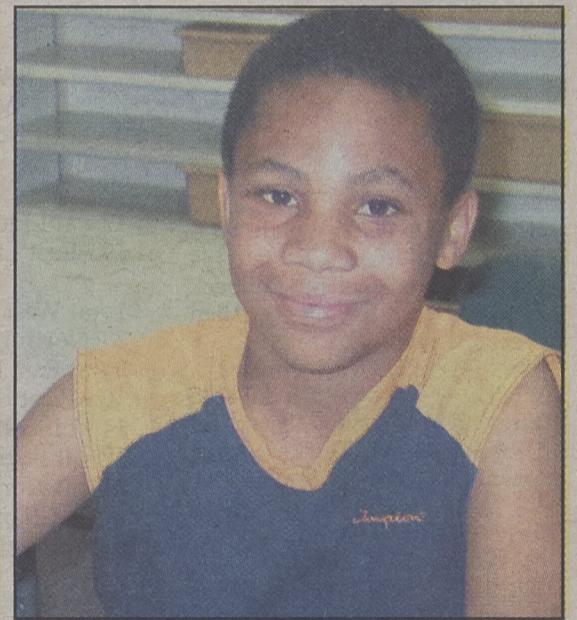
