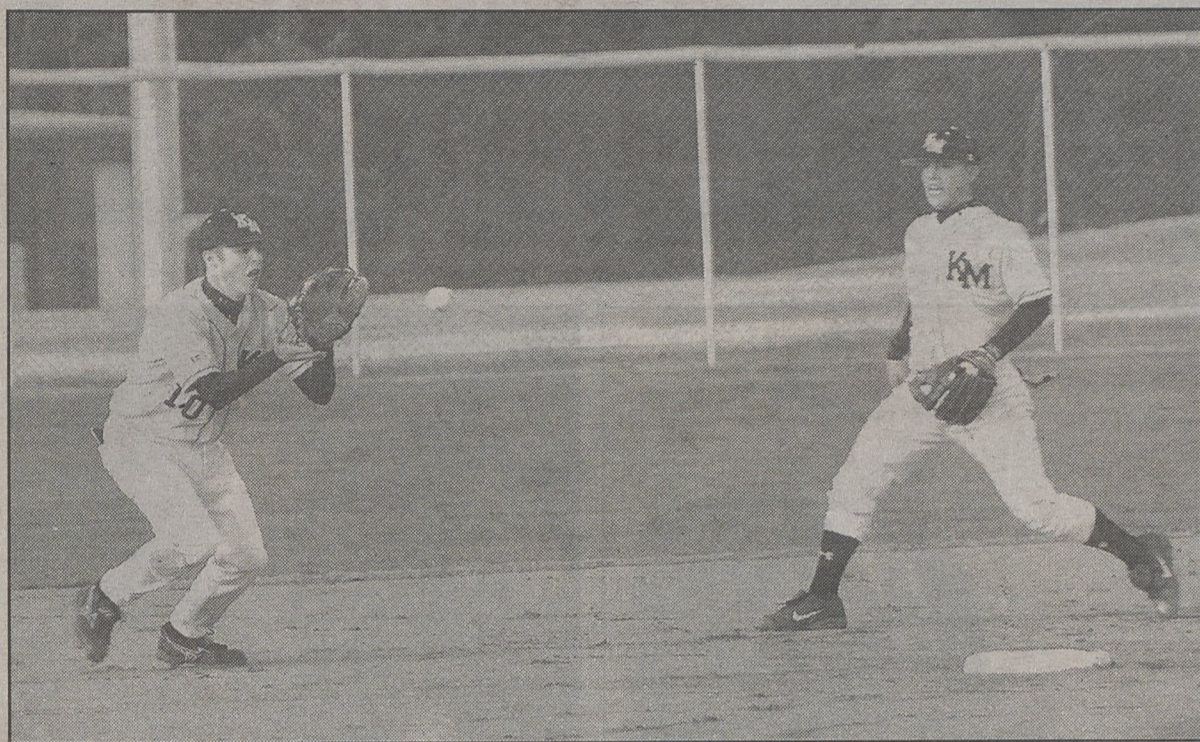

A new U15 club girls volleyball team recently formed in Cleveland County and has performed well in three recent tournaments.

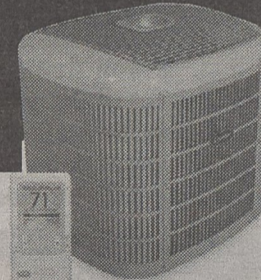
