### Support group for caregivers set for Tuesday at LEC

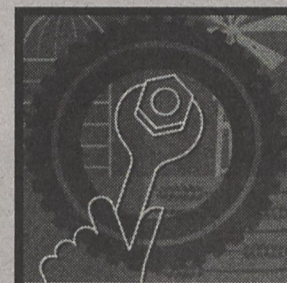
