

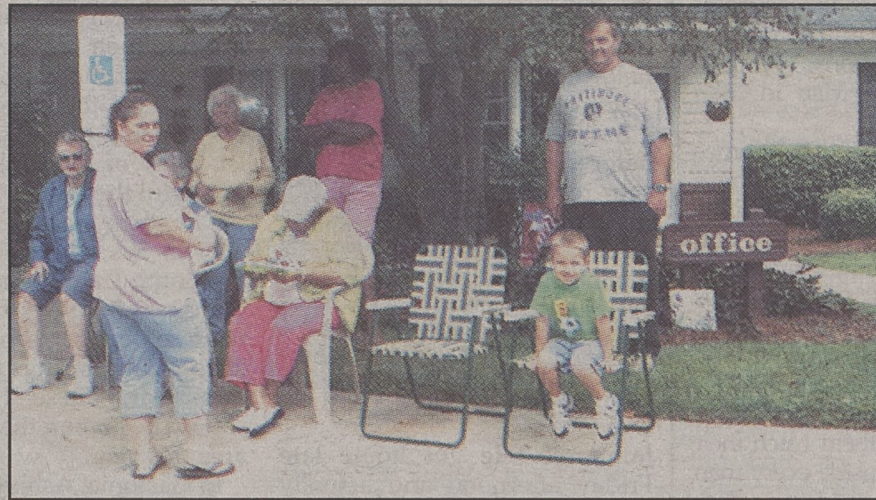

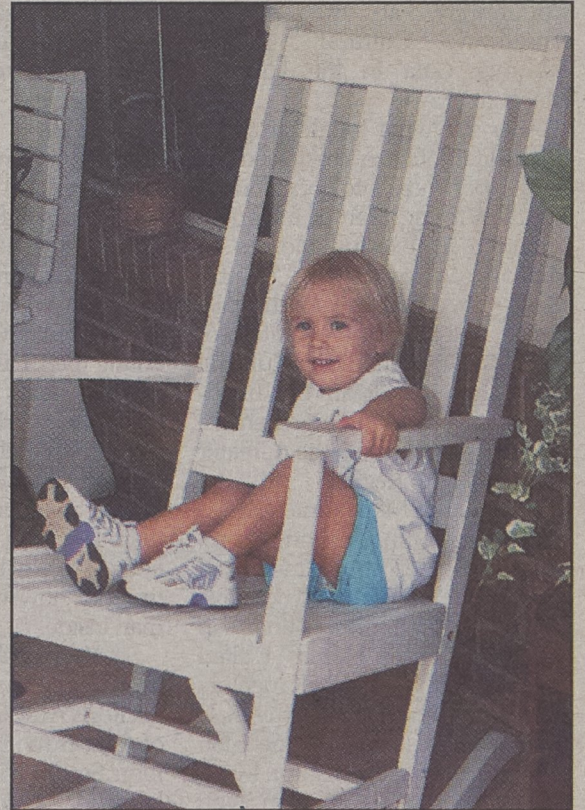

Adam Phillips, 2, enjoys a visit from the KMFd at Battle Forest Apartments on Wednesday afternoon.



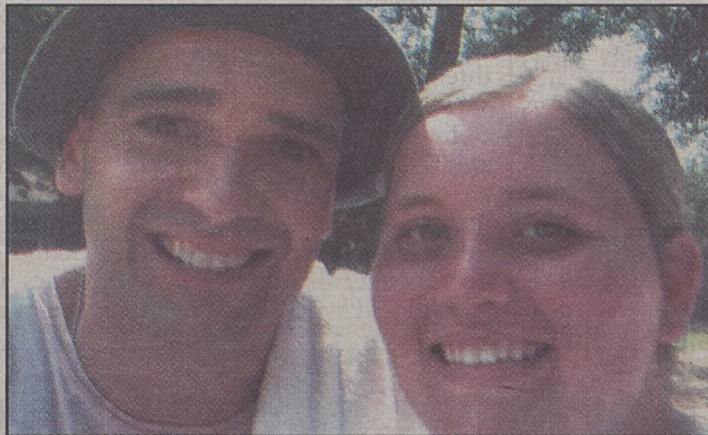
