The business, owned by local home improvement contractor Sam Weir, operated under the names of Crete Magic, Sun Masters and Weir Grafix. Weir has had warrants
issued for his arrest in Lincoln and Meck lenburg counties for failure to perform work after being paid, according to the BBB.
He
He was arrested in Lincoln County on June 15 and is currently out on bail. After
the BBB received several complaints from consumers, the Charlotte-based agency launched an investigation into the company. Results alleged that Weir had defrauded 25 homeowners in eight counties in North Car$\$ 100,000$. Investigations are in progress in Gaston and Cleveland counties.
