Paul also says that we should do this work "gently," which means that we should do it with a spirit of "meekness." In other words, because we are all sinners we realize that each of us sometimes makes a mistake and all of us occasionally need to find "a place where everybody knows our name," and what better place can there be than in a church, which is basically a fellowship of sinners who have been saved by the grace of God?


