# Climbing life's mountains

Psalm 22 begins with the words that Jesus quoted on the cross: "My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?'

A handful of verses later, the psalmist goes on to explain why he would say such a thing. He writes, "Be not far from me, for trouble is near, for there is none to help. Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round."

Bashan was an area located east of the Sea of Galilee. It was a broad and fertile region that was perfectly suited for agriculture, timber and cattle. The large cattle of Bashan were known to the ancient Israelites who first prayed the words of Psalm 22, and they understood what it means to compare life's threats to the "bulls of Bashan."

Even if we don't know much about the region of Bashan, I think almost all of us know about bulls. I am told that a Rodeo bull weighs somewhere between one and two thousand pounds, and it must be frightening to see such a beast chasing after you, and the psalmist compared his troubles to these huge creatures.

Of course, the psalmist also knows that God is more powerful than his enemies and hopefully proclaims, "I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.'

This believer knows by faith that we have something to sing about, even in the midst of life's difficulties, and this something we have to sing about is the Presence and power of God to care for us.

"I met my father for the first time when I was 28 years old," says Gardner, and "I made up my mind that when I had children, my children were going to know who their father was."

This is his reason for not abandoning Christopher to the foster-care system. In

the end, Gardner is the one intern that the firm's management decides to hire for a permanent job. One place Gardner goes






