Shriners' golf tourney June 12 at Woodbridge

The 8th annual Bruce Ward Memorial Golf Tournament, sponsored by the White Plains Shrine Club, will be played June 12 at 1 p.m. at Woodbridge Golf Club in Kings Mountain.

Entry fee is \$65 per person or \$260 for a four-person team. The price includes range balls, BBQ and hole-in-one contests. Mulligans, strings and skirts will be sold the day of the tournament.

The tournament is a Captain's Choice format and begins with a shotgun start at 1 p.m.

decided by a scorecard play-off, with the hole being announced at the tournament.

There will be a special motorcycle hole-in-one contest offered with a Harley-Davidson motorcycle or \$15,000 cash awarded for a hole-in-one. Other hole-in-one contests will be held on all par 3 holes with prizes including a Dell computer system, Bose audio systems and golf equipment.

There will also be closest to the pin and longest drive contests. Door prizes will also be given.

Howard Burnham will portray General Thomas Sumter and Lord Cornwallis and children will get a chance to dress and play as 18th century children did. Jacob's Ladder, rolling hoop, game of graces, and much more are included in the day's event. Learn about breeches, waist coats, petticoats and short gowns. 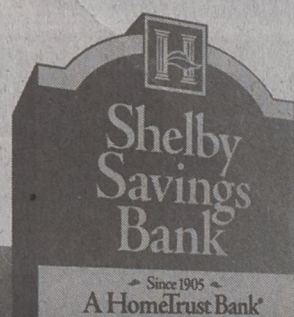
