I pray that what happens in this little story is apocryphal and that it never actually happened, but that does not prevent us being able to draw some lessons from it. It seems that in a certain hospital's Intensive Care Unit, patients always died in the same bed, on Sunday morning, at about 11 a.m., regardless of their medical condition, and this both

alarmed and puzzled the doctors.

Some medical professionals even thought that this unusual occurrence had something to do with the supernatural.
