The man behind Kings Mountain's Relay for Life is Frank Burns, the city's fire chief and a cancer survivor. Burns has lost a brother to bile duct cancer and has stood beside another brother and a sister as they battled and defeated cancer. He has spearheaded the organization of every Relay for Life and was himself diagnosed with prostate cancer in 2006.

Through almost a year of weekly radiation treatments and surgery, he and doctors defeated the cancer and he was declared disease-free in 2007.
