

Sowers Cites County's Contribution to State Industrial Growth

About 300 industrialists, government officials, and businessmen attended a dinner Wednesday night at the Shelby Elks Club in honor of Cleveland County's 145 industries.
The dinner was sponsored by the city of Kings Mountain

city of Shelby, County of Cleveland, and the Shelby Chamber of Commerce, and concluded a day-long observance spotlighting local industries.
Robert Scoggin, chamber president, said the attendance exemplified the spirit of Cleveland County as it obser-

ved Industrial Appreciation Week throughout the state. Several companies had displays of their products exhibited in the ballroom.
Guest speaker for the appreciation dinner was Roy Sowers, Chairman of the North Carolina Dept. of Conservation and Development.

Sowers told his audience that Cleveland County has helped shape the history of North Carolina, and cited the county's share in the state's economic development, pointing out that 100,000,000 - dollars has been spent in capital development by industries in Cleveland County, providing a

\$107 average weekly wage. He then issued a warning that "We must not become so satisfied with what we're doing that we forget the people in our state. It is for the people that North Carolina is interested in industry and natural resources."
"The children of N.C. are

the real focus in this industry appreciation week," said Sowers, "in their eyes we see trust and hope - do not fall that trust."

Fiber Family Members Have Similar Traits

They differ in chemical composition as well as physical properties such as strength, resilience, softness, absorbency, and resistance to sunlight.
This labeling, by generic or family name, makes it easier for you to know what you are buying and what you can expect from your purchase, the specialist says.
The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) requires that textiles be labeled as to percentage by weight of fiber content and that the generic or family name be included with the tradename.
