Gardner-Webb Chorus To Make Tour

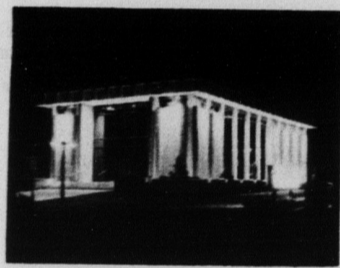
Gardner-Webb College's chorus will make eleven appearances in a two-day tour which will take them into eight high schools, two community colleges and one church on April 27-28.
