## Carolina Speedway Switches To Night Racing

The starting time for Sunday's racing action here at Carolina Speedway has been moved to 8 p.m., according to Promoter Edgar Gault.

Gault said the reason for the change to night racing is to give drivers and mechanics more time to get their cars ready. "We want to give those drivers who have blown engines or wrecked a chance to get them back in shape for Sunday's races," Gault said. "Many drivers have had to set out Sunday racing for this very fact."

Such wasn't the case Sunday as 14 of the area's top Sportsman were on hand for the main event, Carl Smart of Hickory, in a Chevy II grabbed the lead on the first lap and led Daniel Warlick, in a Chevy II, Freddy Smith, in a Mustang, Stick Elliott, in a Chevy II and Mike Duvall, also in a Chevy II, around the track in that order.

J. C. Humphries of Gaffney, after starting at the rear, pushed his way out front to win the Hobby race. Humphries

was followed by Ben Smith of Spartanburg and Doug Cooper of Gastonia. All of these, along with the ever-popular Jerry Bullock of Gaffney, are expected to be on hand Sunday afternoon.

Phillip Eggers of Gaffney, after winning his first race at Carolina, will return along with Eddie Morris, Henry Norman and Gilbert Reynolds. "We're now getting one of the best fields of Sportsman drivers anywhere," Gault said. "We've raised the purse to \$500-\$400-\$300-\$200-\$100 in that order right down through the 15th place and this has helped our field. Also, we have the only Sunday races in the area," he said.

Gates will open at 6 p.m., with racing getting underway at 8. The Sportsman heat races will be run first, followed by the Hobby heat. Then the main event will be run early to give those who have to get to bed early a chance to do so. The Hobby and Rookie mains will be run last.

A big change in the schedule is a Thanksgiving afternoon game with Lenoir Rhyne in Bowling Springs. Last year the Bulldogs and the Bears played in the opening game for both teams.

There are six home games on the schedule with Guilford, Georgetown and Catawba set for night games and Mars Hill, Elon and Lenoir Rhyne set for day games. Mars Hill will be the Bulldogs' homecoming opponent on October 28.

The Bulldogs will open their season with a trip to Newberry, S. C., to play the Indians on September 16. This will be followed by a visit to Birmingham, Ala., to meet Sanford on September 23. Carson-Newman will host the Bulldogs in Jefferson City, Tennessee, on October 21.
