Region C Meet

The Region C Criminal Justice Planning Agency met at the Royal Villa in Kings Mountain on May 18, 1972 at 7:00 p.m. Chairman Tom McDevitt called the meeting to order and welcomed the Policy Board to Kings Mountain. The Chairman also recognized the Rutherford County officials who have just joined the Policy Board. Mr. Sam Haggart and C.W. Williams represented Rutherford County. Mayor John H. Moss of Kings Mountain joined Chief McDevitt in welcoming the Policy Board to Kings Mountain and invited them to come back and visit in Kings Mountain again.

Social Security Increase

Sen. B. Everett Jordan announced this week that he is co-sponsoring legislation to provide a 20-percent across-the-board increase in all Social Security benefits. In making the announcement Jordan stated, "A careful consideration of today's economic condition--constantly climbing prices and continued inflation generally--makes it obvious to me that the 27 million Americans on Social Security simply cannot make ends meet without a substantial increase in Social Security payments."

Jordan said he hopes for early enactment of the bill which, if enacted, will provide a minimum benefit of \$84.50 a month instead of \$70.40. The average benefits would go to \$162 from \$133 a month for retired workers, to \$269 from \$222 for aged couples and to \$153 from \$143 for aged workers.

SOCIAL SECURITY HIKE?

The Senate has indicated its approval of a 20 per cent increase in Social Security benefits. Wilbur D. Mills (D-Ark) chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee earlier proposed a 20 per cent increase.

NEW TREASURER

President Nixon has nominated Budget Director George Shultz as Secretary of the Treasury to replace John Connally, who recently resigned.

APPROVES OIL IMPORTS

President Nixon has approved a 15 per cent increase in oil imports for the remainder of 1972 to offset insufficient U.S. production.

WAGES UP

The Labor Department has reported that wages across the country, both union and nonunion, have risen 3 per cent in the four months since the wage-price freeze ended.
