RECIPE OF THE WEEK

CHINESE CHICKEN
By MRS. HENRY NEISLER

- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1/4 cup salad oil
- 2 boned, raw chicken breasts
- 1 cup onion slices

- 1 1/2 cups celery (cut on bias)
- 2 cups canned chicken broth
- 1 T sugar
- 1 T cornstarch
- 2 T sherry (optional)
- 3 T soy sauce
- 1 can (5 oz) bamboo shoots
- 1 can water chestnuts (sliced)
- Rice or toasted Chow Mien Noodles

Brown pecans in oil, drain on paper towel, reserve oil. Cut chicken into small strips, cook in oil until well done (about six min.). Remove from skillet. Add onion slices, celery and 1/2 cup chicken broth to the oil. Cook five minutes. Combine sugar, cornstarch, sherry, soy sauce and 1 1/2 cups chicken broth. Add celery and onion in skillet. Also add chicken, bamboo shoots and water chestnuts. Heat until thick. Serve on rice or toasted Chow Mien noodles. Serves Six.

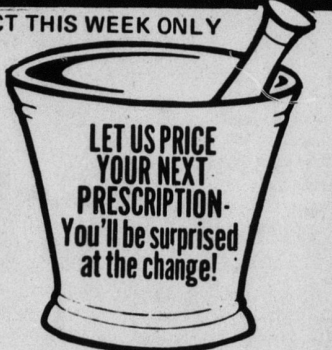
