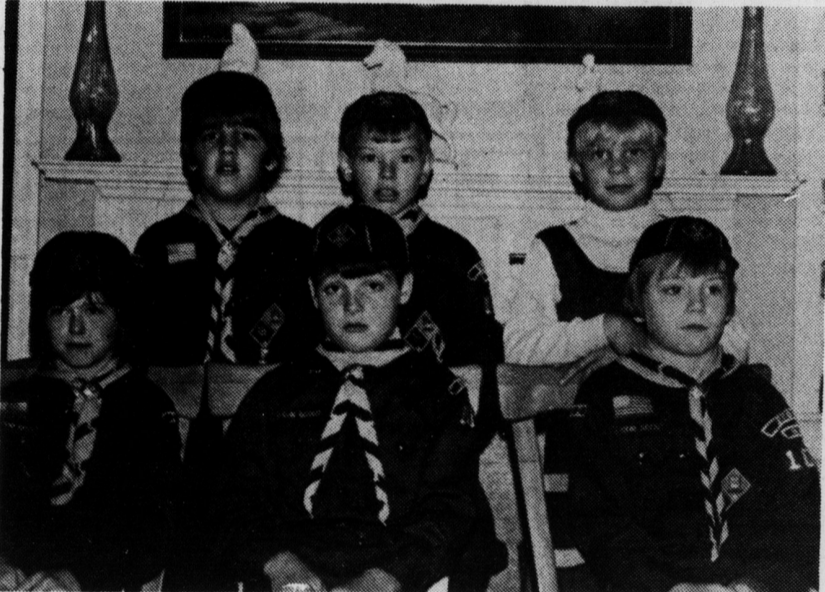

The Cleveland County Health Department is now into Phase Two of its county-wide

immunization for children two to seven years of age. Tuesday and Wednesday the health department mobile units were in Kings Mountain and six different locations. The mobile units will visit three more locales near Kings Mountain today.

May 14-27 has been tentatively set for the third and final phase of immunization shots visits. Final details will be announced later.

Immunizations are given daily at the health department office at Kings Mountain Community Center 9-11 a.m. For further information call the CCHD, 487-8511, Shelby.

Immunizations are being given against measles, rubella, diphtheria, whooping cough, tetanus and polio. It is important that parents bring their children back for their second shots. Tetanus boosters will also be given to adults requesting them.
