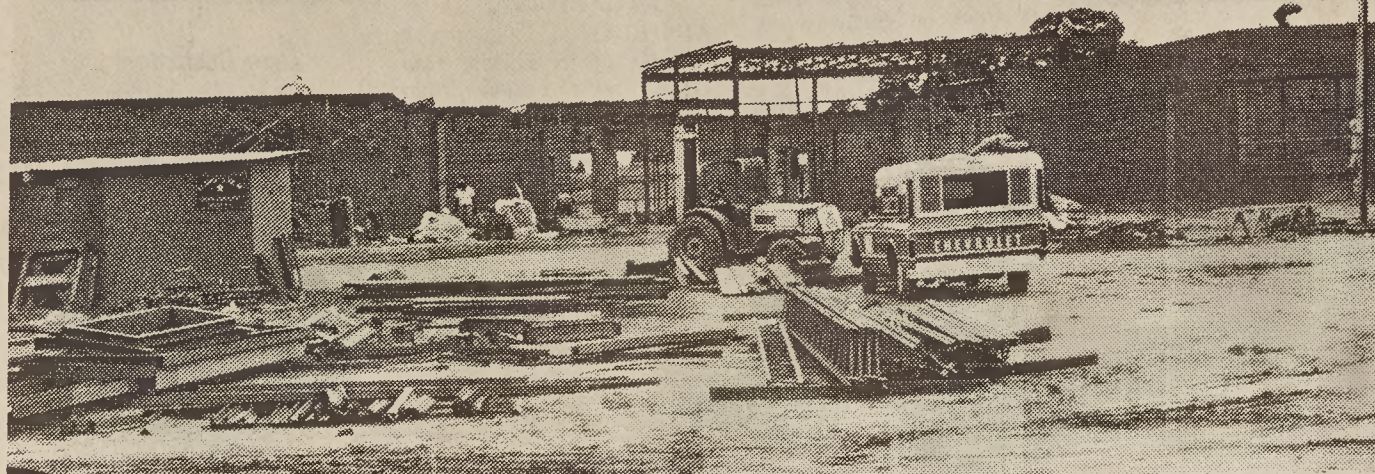

## Shootings Reported To Police

Two accidental shootings in the area hospitalized two people during the weekend and investigation is continuing in the death of a third person who was found shot to death Monday afternoon at his home in Compact Community.

KMPD Chief of Police William Roper said that Carl Bell, 20, was found dead of a shotgun wound of the head Monday afternoon at his home. An autopsy has been ordered and investigation is continuing by Paul Barbee and Det. Sgt. Bob Putnam of the Cleveland County Sheriff's Department.

Viola Alexander, 70, of Chesterfield Apts., was injured in a freak accident shortly after midnight Monday at her home. Chief Roper said that Mrs. Alexander was sitting on a couch with her grandson. The boy was reportedly trying to remove a shell from a shotgun with a pair of pliers. "The boy hit the primer, the shell exploded, blew the pliers from his hand and struck the woman in the left eye", said the Chief. Mrs. Alexander is a patient at Cleveland Memorial Hospital.

Jim Nelson, 20, of Georgetown Apts., reported to KMPD that he was removing a .38 Smith & Wesson from a desk drawer, the gun went off and he was wounded in the side.
