2 small cans mandarin oranges 1 pkg. (6 oz.) orange gelatin

1 pint orange sherbet

Drain oranges and measure juice. Add enough water to make two cups liquid. Bring to

a boil. In hot liquid, dissolve orange gelatin and stir in sherbet until melted. Do not drain pineapple. Add pineapple and drained oranges to mixture. Stir until well mixed. Pour into five-cup mold or 9x12 pan (greased if desired, or rinsed with cold water). Chill until firm.

COTTAGE CHEESE TOMATO ASPIC

2 cans tomato soup, heated 1 jar cottage cheese 1 can sliced, stuffed olives 1 cup finely cut celery ¹/₂ cup mayonnaise 2 envelopes plain gelatin, added to 1/2 cup water.

Add gelatin and water to soup and let cool. When cool,

add the remaining ingredients. Put in salad molds and congeal in refrigerator several hours. Serve on lettuce. This is a good meat substitute. Serves 12.


