Host Tryon meets Bessemer City in the 6:30 opener. First round losers play Tuesday at 6:30 and winners play Tuesday at 8:30.

The double-elimination tournament runs through Saturday, July 26. The winner advances to the state tournament beginning Aug. 4 in Kings Mountain.

to the regular season championship, are coaches of the team.

The National League all-stars will be host for the state tournament and will draw a bye into that event. They'll open State tourney play on Aug. 4 against the District Four champions.

Leaguers win the district title, they would open state tourney play on Aug. 4 against the District Five champions. The other opening day game pits District One against District Two.

## Girls Cage Camp Slated

There will be a basketball camp for girls ages 12-17 at the Kings Mountain Junior High School gym Aug. 4-8.

The camp is under direction of KMJHS coaches Candy Albergine and Becky Summitt. They will be assisted by Jane Biggerstaff, women's basketball coach at Sullen's College in Bristol, Va., and Jayne Arledge, high school player of the year in western North Carolina and the first woman scholarship player ever at Western Carolina University.

Cost of the camp is \$11. That will include insurance and all equipment needed except tennis shoes.

The camp will be broken into two sessions. The morning session will run from 9 a. m. until noon and will be for girls 12-14 years of age. The afternoon session will be from

2-5 p. m. and will be for ages 15-17.

All phases of the game will be covered, the coaches said, including shooting, passing, ballhandling, defense, rebounding and the fast break. Each girl will be placed on a team and will play one full game each day. There will also be competition in free throw shooting and a one on one contest. All-star teams will be chosen at the end of the week.

Coaches Albergine and Summitt said all skill levels will be welcomed as the camp is for beginners as well as established players.

Registration will be held Friday, July 18, and Friday, July 25, from 10 a. m. until noon at the gym. If interested persons cannot attend they should call 739-3343 during the same hours.
