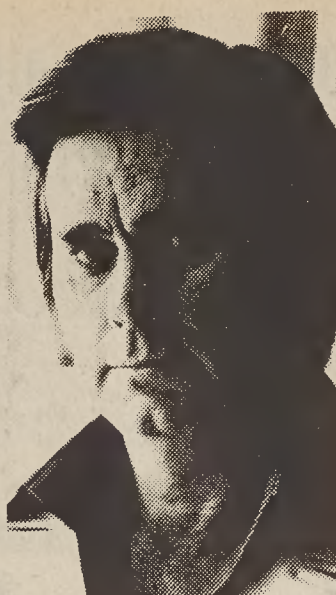
### In School
