The assistance needed is for clothing and household items and may either be brought to or will be picked up by First Presbyterian Church. Call 739-8072.

Household items needed are beds (frames and mattresses), chest of drawers, a refrigerator (priority), washing machine, curtain rods.

Clothing items urgently needed are as follows: Baby boy, age 2½: Size 3 toddler, training pants and shoes, size 6.

Girl, 5-years old: Pants (6 slim), tops, dresses, tops and underwear (size 6) and shoes (size 11).

Twin boys, 7-years old: pants (7 reg.), shirts, shorts, jacket (size 8) and shoes (13).

Girl, 9: Pants (8 reg), tops, dresses, underwear (8), shoes (13½).

Boy, 17: Pants (29 waist, med. length), shirts (boy's 20 or men's small), jacket (man's small) shoes (7½).

Boy, 19: Pants (30 waist, med. length), shirts (14-14½) jacket (man's small) and shoes (9).

Mother: Dresses and pants (10 & 33 waist), blouses (34), bra (34) underwear (5-6) shoes (6).

Father: Pants (30 waist, short length), shirt (man's small) and shoes (6).
