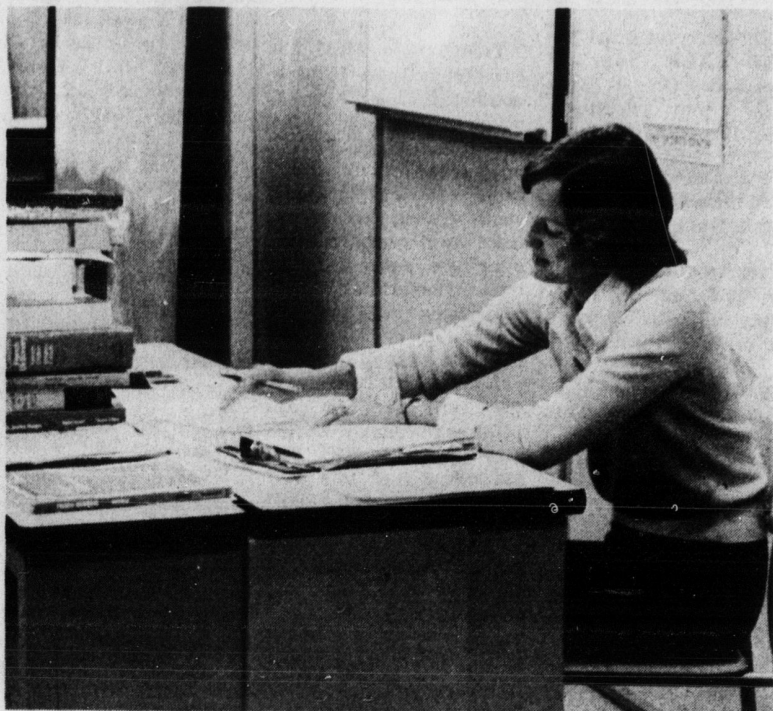


KM Man Charged With Kidnapping

Shepard Wolfe Lanier, 19, of 1010 Sherwood Lane, has been charged with kidnapping and is free under bond of \$10,000.

According to Kings Mountain Police Department records, a warrant alleges that Mary Louise Ramsey, 17, was kidnapped Sept. 21 "by unlawfully confining and restraining and removing her from one place to

another without her consent and for the purpose of terrorizing her."

Det. Robert Dodge, the investigating officer, said that the girl was allegedly kidnapped from a Kings Mountain football game, taken to Georgia, and then returned to Kings Mountain.

Dodge said the girl was unharmed with exception of bruises.
