A number of street improvements petitions have been approved by the city board of commissioners and the scope of the project, according to Comm. Jim Childers, is to make improvements in the form of minor paving or shaping, curb and gutterwork, and paving on existing paved and graveled streets within the city.

Already completed, in Phase I of the project, are Princeton Drive from Fulton Rd. to Dead End, curb, gutter and paving necessary for widening; Wilson St. from Monte Vista to Dead End, paving; Downing St. from Allison Court to Garrison Dr., curb and gutter and paving; Garrison Drive from Townsend Terrace to Suzanne St.

Phase II
Scotland Drive from Phifer to Lee Street, curb & gutter and paving necessary for widening, Somerset Drive from Phifer to Princeton Drive, curb & gutter. Sipes Street from Goforth to Edgemont Drive, paving and curb and gutter. Rhea Street from Maner Road to Fulton Drive, paving and curb and gutter. Marigold Street & Mini Street, paving and curb and gutter. Belvedere Circle, Watterson to Watterson, curb and gutter.

Phase III
Fulton Drive from Margrace Road to Phifer Road, curb and gutter. Slater Street from York Road to Oriental Avenue, curb and gutter. Williamsburg Court, paved.

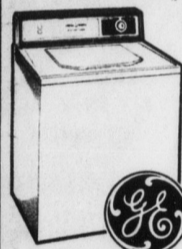
