Must File Estimated Tax Payment By Dec. 17

GREENSBORO — Corporations having expected tax liabilities of at least \$40 for 1979 and operating on a calendar year basis must make an estimated tax payment by December 17, 1979, the Internal Revenue Service said.

The amount of the payment can be computed on Form 1120-W, a worksheet for computing corporation estimated tax. This form need not be filed with the IRS but should be retained by the corporation.

When the payments are deposited in authorized com-

mercial banks or Federal Reserve Banks, they must be accompanied by Federal Tax Deposit Form 508. Supplies of the worksheet and IRS publication 542, "Corporations and the Federal Income Tax," can be obtained at any IRS office.

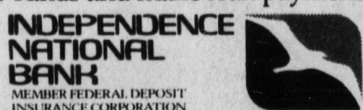

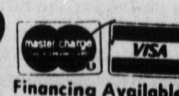
