## **Direct Deposit Is Available**

People receiving social security checks in the Cleveland County area can have them deposited directly into a checking or savings account at a financial institution of their choice, Kenneth Shelton, social security manager said recently.

Of the 14,600 social security beneficiaries and supplemental security income (SSI) recipients in Cleveland County, 3100 (or 21.2 percent of all recipients) currently have their monthly checks being deposited directly into their account at one of our local financial

institutions, Shelton said. Direct deposit has several advantages, he said, including:

--No worry about check being lost.

--No worry about check lying in mailbox when away from home. --Savings in time and transpor-

tation and no standing in line to cash or deposit check.

Money in an account is safer than carrying cash. A person can deal with any

financial institution he or she chooses, including a commercial bank, savings bank, savings and loan association, Federal or State credit union, or similar institution.

Since banking practices vary, a person should find out how the financial institution handles direct deposits, whether a statement is sent, about any service charge, minimum deposits, interest rates, and special services provided.

To arrange direct deposit, a person should complete a form, SF-1199, available at the financial institution. A monthly benefit check shows all the information necessary; so the best time to arrange for the check to be directly deposited would be when the social security or SSI check is received. Take the check with you to the financial organization because the check contains information needed to enable the bank to correctly complete the SF-1199.

Direct deposit only authorizes deposits into your account; it does not authorize withdrawals. For more information, ask for a

copy of the leaflet, "Direct deposit of your monthly benefits," at the Shelby social security office, located at 231 N. Lafayette Street. The telephone number is 482-9544. Are Certified Three new political parties were certified as legal parties in a session of the N.C. State Board of Elections on June 17. The Board reviewed the petitions to organize the parties which had been submitted pursuant to General Statute 163-96 and found said group of petitioners to have qualified as new political parties. The new parties are: Independents for Anderson Party, Citizens Party of N.C., and

to have quained as new pointcal parties. The new parties are: Independents for Anderson Party, Citizens Party of N.C., and Socialist Workers Party. Effective immediately any registered voter may change his registration to affiliate with either of these parties or any unregistered voter may affiliate with either of these parties when registering to vote.

Persons may now register in North Carolina with either of the following parties: Democrat, Republican, Libertarian, Independents for Anderson, Socialist Workers, or Citizens Party of N.C. or they may register Unaffiliated. If a person registers "Unaffiliated" he cannot vote in primary elections, but can vote in all other elections.

The deadline for persons to register to vote in the November 4, 1980 general election is October 6, at 5 p.m. Also a person who has moved from his previous precinct must fill out a precinct transfer form by this date to be eligible to vote. Persons may register at the Cleveland County Board of Elections office or at the home of the precinct registrar or judge of his precinct.
