sons reported during an average statewide reporting period of ten months for this new index offense in 1979. Over 17.5 million dollars worth of property was damaged or destroyed as a result of arson last year.

Edmisten stated, "Approximately 2 murders, 3 rapes, 12 robberies, 51 aggravated assaults, 196 burglaries, 363 larcenies and 34 motor vehicle thefts occurred on the average day in North Carolina last year. Only 25.7 percent of all crimes were cleared by arrests or other means in 1979. The clearance rate for index offenses has now dropped for the fourth consecutive year. Although nearly 70 percent of the violent offenses were cleared, 80 percent of the property crimes remained unsolved."

for almost 100 million dollars worth of property stolen in 1979. Of this 100 million, only 35 million was recovered resulting in a net loss to the people of North Carolina of almost 65 million dollars. Couple this with the losses suffered in property either stolen, damaged or destroyed as a result of cases involving fraud, arson, vandalism, embezzlement, etc. and it is possible that the total cost of crime in North Carolina now exceeds a quarter of a billion dollars a year.

Five North Carolina law enforcement officers were killed in the line of duty last year bringing the total number of officers killed in this state during the 1970's to 40. Recent FBI figures show 106 officers killed in the United States in 1979, with 49 of these deaths occurring in the southern




