Kings Mountain Hospital, Inc. will make available from October 1, 1980, through September 30, 1981, at least \$12,375 of Hill-Burton charity care.

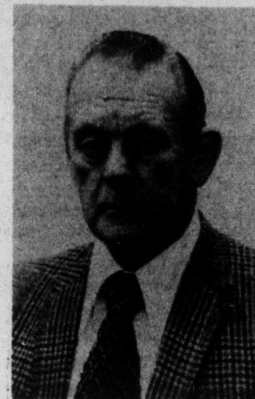

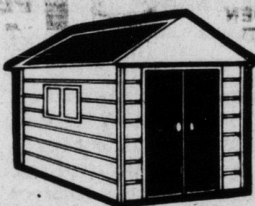
