Kings Mountain High football coach Dan Brooks felt good about his team's chances of winning early in the game last week against Burns.

The Mountaineers received a Burns turnover early in the game, pouncing on a fumble at the 34. Four plays later, the Mounties turned the ball back over at the 25.

The next time the Mounties touched the ball, they drove to the 12 with a first down.

Penalties pushed them back.

Before Brooks knew it, the Bulldogs had their game together and were streaking to a 27-8 victory.

"We didn't take advantage of our breaks, and we made a lot of mental mistakes," said the third-

year coach.

If the Mounties are to win Friday night at home against 4-A Ashbrook, Brooks says they'll have to cut out those mental mistakes.

Ashbrook brings a sound ballclub to Gamble Stadium. The Greenies are 1-0-1, having beaten Chase impressively, 21-7, and tied South Point, 7-7.

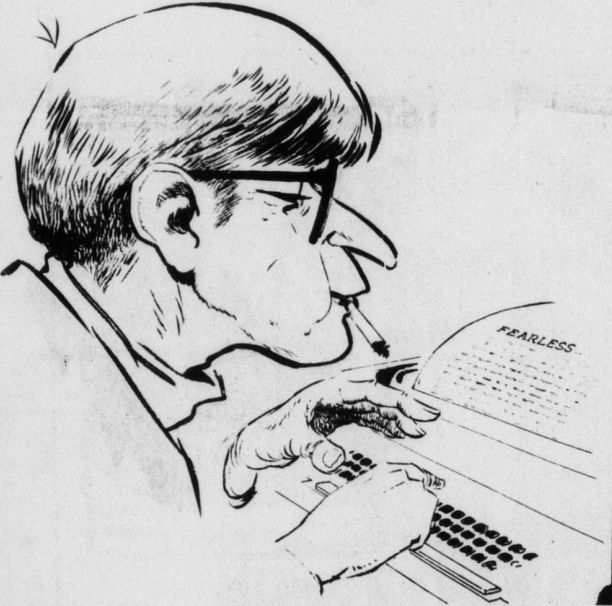
