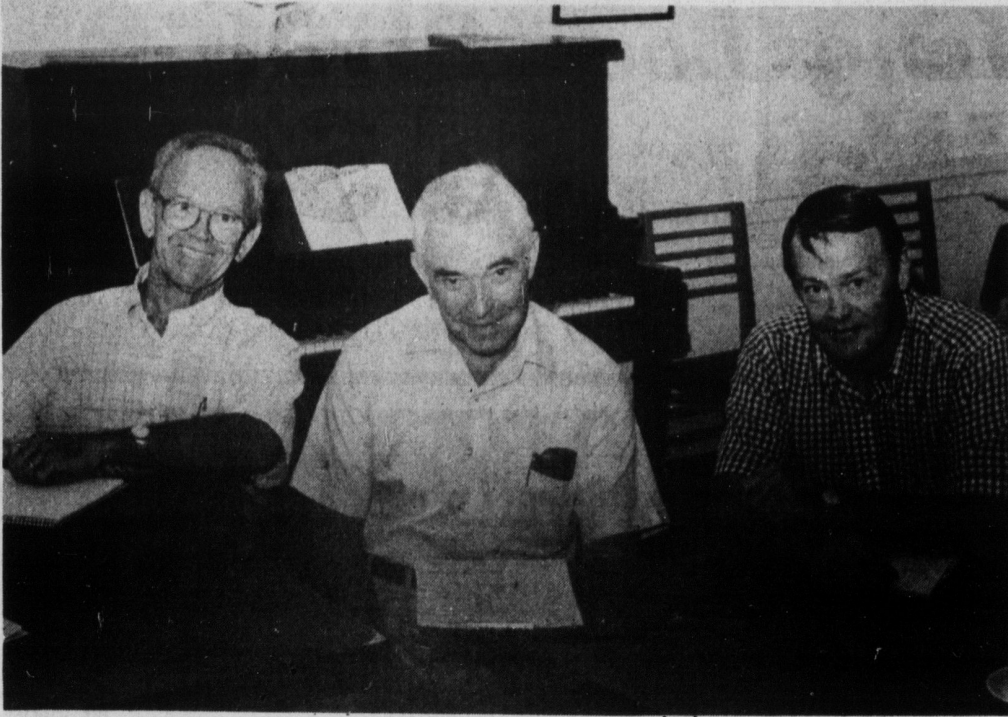

Written by Zipperer, a senior speech and theatre arts major at WCU, "Seed of Damnation" represents the first original, student-written play to be chosen for a major campus production.

During its premiere, the play will be judged as an entry in the 13th annual American College Theatre Festival, a program of the University College Theatre Association which operates as a division of the American Theatre Association.

"Seed of Damnation" is directed by Dr. Donald L. Loeffler, head of WCU's department of speech and theatre arts. Set design is by assistant professor Richard S. Beam, with costume design by instructor Ellyn D. Brannick.

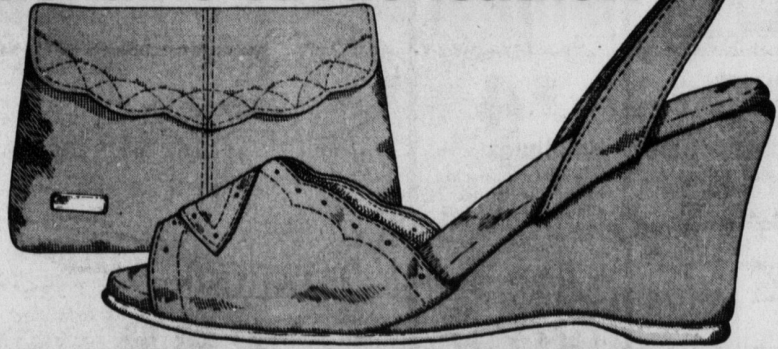
