Door prizes were presented and wives of Radio Club members received Christmas presents.

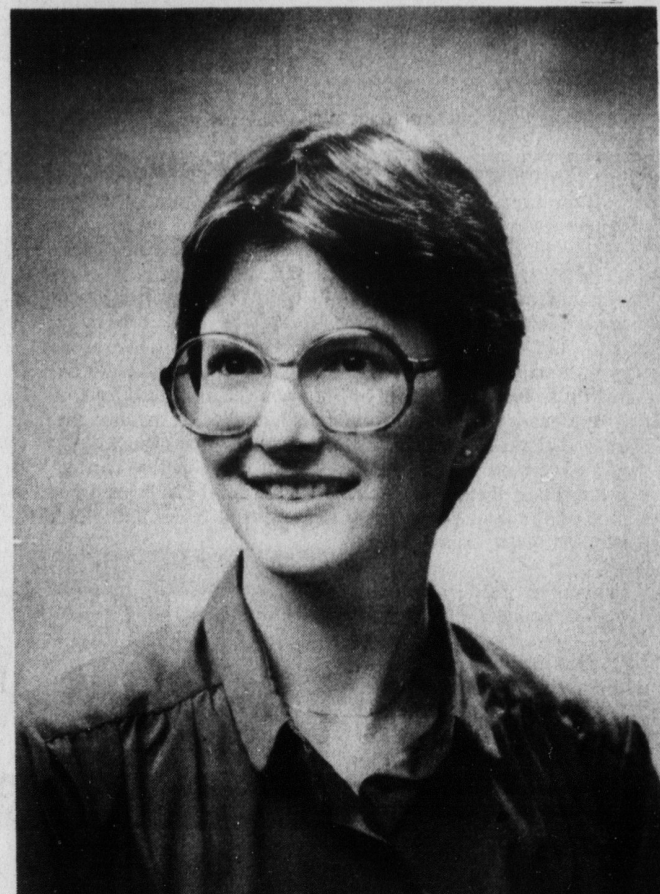
### Youth Choirs Are Rehearsing

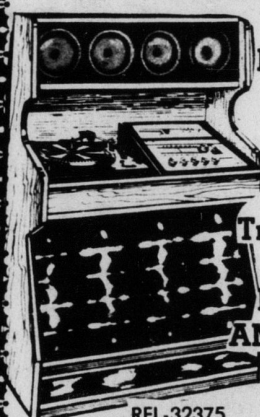

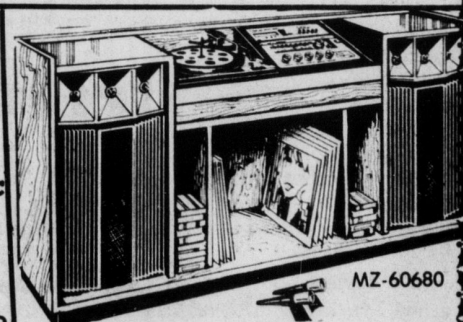
