Ronald Queen to keep our promise on the water".

Mrs. Byers and Philbeck said they were totally opposed to constructing the line on undeveloped properties unless the property owners share the expense of the line. "Is he willing to share any of the expense of the costs?", asked Philbeck. Comm. Queen said that Hambright and Herndon had indicated they were not.

The board, by a unanimous vote, agreed to hire a second school crossing guard at cost of \$1,072.00 for the school year and buy the uniforms and voted to receive applications at the next meeting.

Mayor W.W. McCarter questioned the need for an additional guard, noting that normally two to four children walk in the area of Highway 226 where the new guard is to be employed to help children cross the street as they go to and from Grover School. Comm. Philbeck pointed out that Highway 226 is curvy and a dangerous crossing with heavy tankers and big trucks on the road at 3 p.m. when children walk from school. Comm. Moss added that "we may be over reacting but I don't think Grover taxpayers will disagree with putting two crossing guards out there."
